- Vocational qualifications (e.g., BTECs, Diplomas)
- Apprenticeships (earning while you learn)
- Foundation courses to boost your qualifications

# Get in Touch with Your Chosen College or Sixth Form

Most colleges have advisors ready to talk you through your options. You may still be able to:

- Join your chosen course (some courses have flexible entry requirements)
- Switch to a different course or level
- Resit GCSEs alongside further study

#### Consider Resits

You can retake English and Maths GCSEs (it's often expected if you haven't achieved at least a Grade 4). Colleges can help you plan to resit while studying another course.
