Tasks

Task 1

Plan a presentation about a well-known genre of music. Chose from the styles that you will be studying on the Music Technology course:

- Jazz
- Blues
- Rock 'n' roll
- Rock
- Metal
- Punk
- Soul
- Disco and funk
- Reggae
- Acoustic and folk
- Commercial pop
- Urban
- Electronic and dance

You must include the following:

- Artists
- Famous record labels
- Key producer
- Albums
- Musical features
- Roots of the style (musical features)
- At least recorded examples of it

Extension

- Research recording and production techniques.

You will be asked to present this in the first two weeks of term in September, so you need to prepare this over the summer holiday.
