Mathematics A Level

We are asking all students to complete some Independent Preparatory Work over the summer, before they join Year 12 in September. You will need to bring this work to lessons as the content will be assessed through introductory assessments which will be completed within the few first weeks of the new term.

Tasks

If you attended the taster sessions on 1st July then you will have had the opportunity to create an account with Integral – the online platform that is providing the course materials for the mandatory summer work.

Once registered check your email account for your user name.

Your password will be sent to you via a second email.

Once you have both emails, log in and the first thing you need to do is change your password, or you can't continue.

The course you require is **Transition to A level Mathematics**.

It contains a number of modules for you to work through recapping your GCSE skills on the core topics needed to be successful at the start of the A level course.

Once you have completed all the modules with their end of unit assessment you will have the option to print a certificate.
