Why should I consider it?

Volunteer – if you're not a volunteer already, a chance to join, train and volunteer in your local community

Placements – enhance your CV with 20 hours of observational clinical experience in your local hospital and gain insight into health care roles

Practical skills – hands on basic life support, manual handling training and de-escalation skills, whilst also learning about developing your own wellbeing and resilience

Next steps – enhance career awareness for nursing and health care, or further study/apprenticeship
