**Volunteer –** if you're not a volunteer already, a chance to join, train and volunteer in your local community

**Placements –** enhance your CV with 20 hours of observational clinical experience in your local hospital and gain insight into health care roles

**Practical skills** – hands on basic life support, manual handling training and de-escalation skills, whilst also learning about developing your own wellbeing and resilience
