T LEVELS

Our first three T Level courses launched last September in Engineering, Education and Childcare and Health.

T Levels are the new academic qualification on the block. Equivalent to three A levels, they combine the career focus and practical elements of current technical and professional qualifications like BTECs and NVQs, with the theory and study of traditional A Levels. What makes T Levels unique is that students will apply the theory they learn in the classroom to the workplace on an industry-based placement, ensuring they have career-ready skills, giving them a head start towards the career they want.
